


Madhva Pradesh Maui

Description

Madhya Pradesh: Popularly known as the heart of India, Madhya Pradesh is famous for its natural beauty and cultural heritage. Jhansi: The city of Jhansi is located on the banks of Pahuj River in the Indian state of Uttar Pradesh. The historical city of Jhansi is famous for the heroic Maratha kingdom. Rani Lakshmi Bai of Jhansi fought heroically with the British in the India's struggle for freedom during the revolt of 1857. The city was previously known as Shankargarh during the reign of Bundelas. The city of Jhansi is the administrative headquarter of the Jhansi district and the Jhansi division. The city attracts tourists from all across India as well as foreign visitors due to the presence of majestic forts and temples. Mere reference to the name 'Jhansi' evokes the spirit of patriotism in the hearts of Indians. The land of Jhansi is the birthplace of several brave heart rulers and warriors who contributed greatly towards India's struggle for freedom. Khajuraho: A small town located in the Bundelkhand region in Madhya Pradesh, Khajuraho is a brilliant example of Indian architecture and its culture back in the medieval period. The architecture of these Hindu and Jain temples depict the innocent form of love, the carvings on the walls display passion in the most erotic yet aesthetic ways. Built between 950 to 1050 AD the sheer confrontational nature of these carvings show a stark paradox with the conventional Indian ideals about eroticism, leaving everybody spellbound. Art in this small town is engrained in all of its structures and are a classic example of the finesse of India's cultural and artistic heritage.

Attractions and Shopping Tips

Khajuraho: temples of Khajuraho, the temples are unique in architecture and stunning in their ornamentation.

Shopping at Khajuraho: Sculptures of brass, iron or stone depicting Kama Sutra poses are a specialty of Khajuraho and are available at the handicraft stores and at Crafts Emporium, on Jain Temple Road. A weekly bazaar is held on Tuesdays at Rajinagar – 5 Km from Khajuraho and has a good selection of silver and brass - ware.

Jhasi: Jhansi Museum, Fort of Jhansi, Maha Lakshmi Temple, Rani Mahal & Many more.

Shopping in Jhansi: Jhansi is not a major shopping destination. Jhansi is famous for intricately designed glass bangles which can be bought from Sipri Bazaar. The main shopping markets in Jhansi are: Mani Chowk, Sadar Bazaar, Sipri Bazaar and Nagra. The markets offer a variety of clothes, books, electronics and antiques to buy.

Day 1: Jhansi [By Train]

On arrival at Jhansi, meet with our representative & transfer to the hotel. In the afternoon visit a half day city tour of Jhansi covering Fort, Museum and Rani Mahal. Return back to hotel in the evening for dinner & Overnight stay at Hotel.

Day 2: Jhansi - Orchha - Khajuraho (180 KMs)

After an early breakfast check out from the hotel and drive to Khajuraho via Orchha. On arrival at Orchha, visit to Orchha fort. As there are many temples within the fort, three are especially worth visiting. Visit to Ram Raja, Chaturbhuj and Lakshmi Narayan Temple. In the afternoon, a continue drive to Khajuraho. On arrival at Khajuraho, check into the hotel. Enjoy dinner & Overnight stay at hotel in Khajuraho.

Day 3: Khajuraho

This morning after breakfast in the hotel proceed for full day sightseeing of Khajuraho visit Eastern & Western Group of Temple's. Explore the light & sound show in the evening. Later, return back to hotel for dinner & Overnight stay at hotel.

Day 4: Khajuraho - Jhansi railway station (180 Ms)

After an early breakfast leave from Khajuraho and directly drive to Jhansi Railway station to board the train and head for the onward journey.
