Description

The **Seven Sister States** are the contiguous states of Arunachal Pradesh, Assam, Meghalaya, Manipur, Mizoram, Nagaland and Tripura in northeastern India.

These states cover an area of 255,511 square kilometres (98,653 sq mi), or about seven percent of India's total area. As of 2011 they had a population of 44.98 million, about 3.7 percent of India's total. Although there is great ethnic and religious diversity within the seven states, they bear similarities in the political, social and economic spheres.

Tour Highlights

GUWAHATI

Guwahati is the ancient Shakti temple of Goddess Kamakhya in Nilachal hill (an **important** seat of Tantric and Vajrayana Buddhism), the ancient and unique astrological temple Navagraha in Chitrachal Hill, and archaeological remains in Basistha and other archaeological locations of mythological **importance**.

SHILLONG:

Shillong was a small village until 1864, when it became the new civil station of the Khasi and Jaintia hills. It remained the

summer capital of Eastern Bengal and Assam for many years. In 1874, on the formation of Assam as a Chief Commissioner's Province, it was chosen as the capital of the new administration.

KAZIRANGA:

The park is home to large breeding populations of elephants, wild water buffalo, and swamp deer. **Kaziranga** is recognized as an **Important** Bird Area by BirdLife International for conservation of avifaunal species. The park celebrated its centennial in 2005 after its establishment in 1905 as a reserve forest.

Dirang is a village in the Indian state of Arunachal Pradesh¹ West Kameng is the name of the district that contains village Dirang.

TAWANG:

BOMDILA:

Bomdila is the headquarters of West Kameng district in the state of Arunachal Pradesh in India. Bomdile is one of the 60 constituencies of the state of Arunachal Pradesh. The MLA for this region (in August 2016) is **Japu Deru**.

BHALUKPUNG:

Bhalukpung is a small town located along the southern reaches of the Himalayas in West Kameng district of Arunachal Pradesh in India. The town is located at 213m above sea level,100 km from Bomdila, 52 km from Tezpur and 5 km from Tipi. It lies along the Kameng river and is the headquarters of Bhalukpung circle. Bhalukpung was governed by local tribal Aka rulers, with occasional political dominance from Bhutan and Assam

NAMERI

Nameri National Park is a national park in the foothills of the easternHimalayas in the Sonitpur District of Assam, India, about 35 km fromTezpur. Nameri is about 9 km from Chariduar, the nearest village. Nameri shares its northern boundary with the Pakhui Wildlife Sanctuary of Arunachal Pradesh. Together they constitute an area of over 1000 km² of which Nameri has a total area of 200 km

UMIAM LAKE:

Umiam Lake (commonly known as barapani lake) is a reservoir located in the hills 15 km to the North of Shillong in the state of Meghalaya, India. It was created by damming the Umiam river in the early 1960s. The principal catchment area of the lake and dam is spread over 220 square km.

Attractions and Shopping Tips

GUWAHATI: kamakhya temple , umananda temple , assam state zoo cum botonical garden , srimanta sankarddev kalaksheta , dipor bill , assam state museum , balaji temple garden.

GUWAHATI SHOPPING TIPS:

Apparels made of Assamese silk (Pat, Muga etc.), Cotton clothes with traditional thread work, Artistic wall hangings, caps and shawls, Hairclips and fashion accessories made of bamboo, Tribal art Brass utensils, Toys made of clay, Laichampi (traditional blanket)

TAWANG: Jang Falls, India, Tawang War Memorial, Tawang Monastery Museum

TAWANG Shopping Tips: shawls, Chadors (wrap around skirts for women), hand-crafted bags and tribal dresses.

BOMDILA: Bomdila Monastery, Holiday Scout, Bomdila View Point, Apple Orchards

BOMDILA SHOPPING TIPS: buying Tibetan carpets, paintings and thangkas which make for excellent souvenirs.

DIRANG: Dirang Dzong, national Research Centre On Yak, Hot Water Spring, Sangti Valley

SHILLONG: Elephanta Falls, Nohkalikai Falls, Umiam Lake, Air Force Museum

KAZIRANGA: One Horned Rhinoceras, Coffee And Rubber Plantations.

NAMERI: Bura-Chapori Wildlife Sanctuary, Agnigarh

BHALUKPUNG: Pakhui Wildlife Sanctuary, Kaziranga National Park, Bhalukpong Fort, Tipi

Itinerary

Entry / Exist Point of tour

Entry : Guwahati Exit : Guwahati

DAY 01: ARRIVAL AT GUWAHATI AIRPORT / RLY STN.

Arrival at Guwahati airport or Rly stn, meet & greeted & transfer to Hotel. Later visit Sankardeva Kalakhetra, Balaji temple etc. Overnight stay in Guwahati.

DAY 02: LOCAL SIGHTSEEING IN GUWAHATI (130 KMS / 3 ½ hrs drive):

Today morning after breakfast @ 8 AM, start for full day local sightseeing including visit to Kamakhya temple, Navagraha temple, Umananda temple, state Zoo. Evening enjoy sunset River cruise over the river Brahmaputra (**Cruise** is subject to weather conditions & availability, PAYMENT WILL BE DIRECT). Overnight in Guwahati.

DAY 03: Guwahati - Shillong

After an early breakfast, depart for Shillong (130 kms / 3 ½ hrs drive). Check in at the hotel. Overnight is in Shillong.

DAY 04: Shillong - Cherrapunjee - Shillong

Today, you will be traveling to Cherrapunjee – one of the wettest places. Overnight stay at Shillong.

DAY 05: Shillong – Mawphlang – Shillong (Meghalaya)

Today, you will be travelling to Mawphlang and surrounding excursions. Drive back to Shillong for overnight halt. Overnight stay in Shillong.

DAY 06: Shillong – Umiam Lake (Meghalaya)

Today, you will be traveling to Umiam Lake. Relax last leg of journey at RiKynjai. Overnight is in Umiam Lake.

DAY 07: Shillong – Kaziranga (300 Kms / 7 hrs)

After breakfast transfer to Kaziranga National Park. Check in hotel. Evening at leisure. Overnight at Kaziranga.

DAY 08: Kaziranga – Elephant and Jeep Safari

This morning wake up early for your elephant safari. Return for breakfast. Afternoon Jeep safari in central range. Overnight stay at Kaziranga.

DAY 09: KAZIRANGA – BHALUKPONG(150 Kms / 4 hrs drive)

After leisurely breakfast drive to Bhalukpong (150 Kms / 4 hrs drive). Check in hotel. Afternoon visit Local markets. Overnight at Bhalukpong.

DAY 10: Bhalukpong – Bomdila - Dirang

After breakfast, proceed by car to the boat embankment point (8 km) and come down by boat on the snow-fed Himalayan river (rubber dinghies oared by expert tribal boatmen). This is not a rafting activity, but something that is rather unique to the JiaBhorelli River.Later, proceed on the 167 km hill road to Dirang. Within half an hour cross into Arunachal Pradesh at Bhalukpong and begin the steep ascent to Bomdila and further 2 hrs away to Dirang (180 kms/5 hrs). Overnight at Dirang.

DAY 11: Dirang

Today enjoy the day soaking in the splendour of the Dirang Valley and its neighbourhood. Overnight at Dirang.

DAY 12: Dirang – Sela Pass - Tawang

Today after breakfast, depart Dirang for a fascinating drive to Tawang. Overnight at Tawang.

DAY 13: Tawang

After breakfast drive high above town to the high altitude lakes of Pangong Tang Tso (popularly known as PT Tso). Overnight at Tawang.

DAY 14: Tawang – Bomdila

Your return journey begins with your drive to Bomdila. Overnight stay at Bomdila.

DAY 15: Bomdila - Nameri

After an early breakfast, return to Nameri eco-camp. Overnight at Nameri.

DAY 16: Nameri – Guwahati Airport drop(230 Kms / 5 hrs drive)

After breakfast, drive to Guwahati airport (230 Kms / 5 hrs drive). Tour Ends Here.
