Description

Rajasthan is culturally rich and has artistic and cultural traditions which reflect the ancient Indian way of life. Kathputli,Bhopa, Chang, Teratali, Ghindr, Kachchhighori, Tejaji, etc. are the examples of the traditional Rajasthani culture. Rajasthan is known for its traditional, colourful art. The block prints, tie and dye prints, Bagaru prints, Sanganer prints, and Zari embroidery are major export products from Rajasthan. UDAI[PUR Shopping Tips: handicrafts, toys, bewitching puppets, wall hangings, pen stands, cloth lanterns, handmade papers, painted wooden box to Greeting cards, Pottery covers all kinds of pots, plates, vessels and different kinds of containers. Itinerary

• ENTRY AND EXIT POINT OF TOUR:

Entry : Jaipur Exit : Jodhpur

Day 1: Arrive in Jaipur

In the morning, we will pick you from your desired location in Jaipur. Chk In at Jaipur Hotel. In the afternoon, visit major attractions in Jaipur including the City Palace, Jantar Mantar, Hawa Mahal & Birla Temple. Evening is free for leisure. Later, stay overnight at the hotel.

Day 2: Jaipur

After breakfast, proceed to visit Amber Fort & Nahargarh Fort. Enjoy shopping in the evening and later spend a comfortable overnight stay at the hotel.

Day 03: Jaipur - Pushkar (145 KM - 3 HRS)

After breakfast, check out from hotel then drive to Pushkar:15kms from Ajmer, is a sacred town for the Hindus, situated 11 kms. to the North-West of Ajmer.Evidence points to its having existed during the fourth century B.C. lake in the inhospitable surroundings of a desert is no less than a miracle.Brahma is supposed to have performed sacrifice at this lake on Kartik Purnima (the full moon day of the Kartik month) hallowing the place. Sacred to Brahma, Pushkar boasts of its temple dedicated to him, which is the only one of its kind in the world. A dip in the waters of Pushkar and worship at his temple ensure salvation. So thousands flock to Pushkar to observe the ritual on kartik Purnima, or on any of the four days preceding it. Arrive at Pushker ,transfer to hotel,check in to hotel,take rest ,Later visit the most famous is the Brahma Temple, said to be one of the few temples in the world dedicated to this deity. It's marked by red spire, and over the entrance gateway is the hans, or goose symbol, of Brahma, who is said to have personally chosen Pushkar as its site. Also visit the Pushkar Lake. Overnight stay at hotel in Pushkar.

Day 04: Pushkar - Udaipur (300 KM / 6 HRS)

After breakfast, check out from hotel then drive to Udaipur

Udaipur :formally known as the city of lakes and Venice of East. Udaipur, the capital of the former princely state of Mewar is a beautiful city in Rajasthan, India. Udaipur is also referred to as the "Venice of the East", the "Most Romantic City of India" and the "Kashmir of Rajasthan". Udaipur the "City of Lakes" is one among the most romantic and most beautiful cities of India. The city of Dawn, Udaipur is a lovely land around the azure water lakes, hemmed in by the lush hills of the Aravalis. A vision in white drenched in romance and beauty, Udaipur city of Rajasthan state is a fascinating blend of sights, sounds and experiences - an inspiration for the imagination of the poets, painters and writers. Their reflection in the placid waters of the Lake Pichhola is an enticing sight.

Enroute visiting Ranakpur temples with their beautiful carvings and the marble complex of Adinath shrine that has 1444 columns.Ranakpur is one of the most important five pilgrimage places of rajasthan, it is the pilgrimage hub of Jainism.It is known for peaceful nature of the flowers of Jainism.

Arrive at Udaipur, transfer to hotel, check in to hotel, take rest, free for leisure, overnighjt stay at hotel at Udaipur.

Day 05: Udaipur

After breakfast visit to sight seeing tour of Udaipur. Enjoy picturesque lake Pichola set on the backdrop of Aravali hills, established in 1559 by Maharana Udai Singh, is nick named as 'Kashmir of Rajasthan' or 'Venice of the East', owing to its natural beauty; enchanting location and picturesque surroundings. The City Palace museum, the Jagdish temple, Sahelion Ki Bari (Queen's resort for their friends) Bhartiya Lok Kala Mandir (Folk art museum) and the Pratap Memorial.

Later back to hotel . Rest of the day free for leisure. Overnight stay at hotel in Udaipur.

Day 6: Udaipur - Jodhpur

After early breakfast, drive to Jodhpur. Upon arrival check in at hotel. City tour of Jodhpur - the largest city in Rajasthan after Jaipur, Jodhpur stands at the edge of the Thar Desert. Here you will visit Mehran Garh Fort, Jaswant Thara, Mandore Garden Umaid Bhawan Palace and Museum. Overnight at hotel.

Day 7: Jodhpur

Breakfast at Hotel. Late afternoon tour of Jodhpur - with a visit to Meherangarh Fort - one of the most impressive and formidable in the whole of fort - studded Rajasthan. Overnight at hotel.
